CONDITIONALS: CONDITIONAL TYPE 2

If **cláusula** en past simple / **cláusula principal** en Conditional "**WOULD + verb infinitive**".

Ex. : If I **had** time, I **would go** shopping.

If She **got** up early, She **would arrive** on time.

(Si sucediera esto, pasaría esto otro).

"if" clause	main clause
<u>If</u> I won a million dollars,	... I would put the money in a bank. ... I could buy an airplane. ... I might give it all away.
main clause	"if" clause
I would put the money in a bank I could buy an airplane I might give it all away	... <u>if</u> I won a million dollars.
